PYO*	BE Novice – Test 130 (2016)	Elementary

*Class 4 may be split across levels if entries warrant. You can enter both tests if you wish.

Classes may be split Junior/Senior or Open/Restricted as appropriate. Please indicate which category you are in when filling in the online entry form. (Definitions are on the [entry form](#)).

Entry Fees:

- Members: £9 per test, £16.50 for two tests.
- Non-Members: £10 per test, £18.50 for two tests.

Video Submission Deadline: **Saturday 20/03/21 @ 1800.**

Results Posted On: **Saturday 27/03/21** on Facebook & via email to all competitors.

Competition Rules:

- Dressage Tests may be ridden in any 20m x 40m arena on a surface or on grass.
The arena can be 'homemade', please ensure the letter markers are clearly visible on camera.
- Dress can be either smart casual or in competition dress; plaiting is optional.
- BD Tack Rules apply e.g. no boots / quarter sheets / martingales
If in doubt please ask, or check the BD Tack rules [here](#).
- All Tests may be called, as long as COVID security measures are being adhered to.
- Tests can be ridden with a whip.
- If any of the Comp Rules are broken, if there is an issue with the arena, or with the video, then the competitor will be HC but will still receive written feedback on their test(s).
- We will try to contact anyone, before the deadline, if we spot an issue with their video.

How to Video:

- The person videoing must be standing a few metres behind C, holding the camera/phone **landscape** and where possible zooming in to see the horse and rider more clearly, particularly at the top end of the school.
- Ask the person videoing to confirm the test being ridden, rider name, and horse name before the rider starts their test. If you are filming yourself, then make your introduction and then circle the arena to enter at A to start your test.
- Ask the person videoing to keep you and the horse in the centre of the screen at all times, as the judge must be able to see all the movements clearly to mark the test; the judge will not be able to score you if they cannot see the movements (i.e. not too close up in circles so the judge can see the accuracy of the shape ridden)
- The test must be completed in one continuous session i.e. no cuts.
- The video must have sound and start at least a few seconds before the rider enters at A, and continue for a few seconds after the rider salutes at the end.
- Make sure that you are not videoing directly into the sun.
- Equally, if the video is too dark the judge will not be able to mark your test accurately so do adjust camera/phone light settings, and ensure you/your horse are clearly visible against your surroundings.
- NB: Each video submitted must not have been previously judged.

After Filming:

- Upload your video to YouTube and label it with the **test being ridden, your name** and the **horse's name**. Please test that it works before you send it to us.
- Complete the video submission form [here](#), before **1800 on 20/03/21**
(Should your YouTube page have a password, please include that info on the form where prompted.)
- If you do not have / do not want a YouTube account, then please send your video via WhatsApp to **07929 181 150**. This will then be uploaded to a private YouTube account for judging.
