Onley Grounds Equestrian—Dressage April 2023

Netty did a super test to finish mid field in a competitive novice section.

Super sub Bizzy and Darren (standing in for Rosie Bathurst who unfortunately had to withdraw due to horse injury) smashed it with a super score of 70% and finished 3rd.

Overall the team finished 18th out of 34. Well done to you all.

In April, three ERC members took part in the **Combined training qualifiers at Allen's Hill**. Fe Moore, Vicky Clements and Sue Deer. Fe Moore and her mare Daisy did a super job after a couple of years out to finish 4th. Sue Deer came a brilliant 2nd. Vicky did a superb dressage but it was not her day for SJ.

Fe and Sue went onto the **Championships at Aston le Walls** in May, where Fe finished 10th and Sue 11th. Well done to you both. Also at these Championships were Grace Chapple and Becky Cooper-Brice—who had qualified from the **Combined Challenge** in March at Dallas Burston, reported in the April newsletter. Becky did a super double clear with just a few time faults to finish mid field (pictures on the following page). Grace and Flicker did a super clear round in the show jumping but Flicker had clearly had enough and was reluctant to leave the start box for the cross country. However, a huge well done for getting to the Championships!

A series Champion and Runner Up will be presented with prizes at the championship show (the final one in the series) and there will be rosettes to 6th. The championship and points league is only open to ERC members.
